## SRF Public Pool is now open!

The Smooth Rock Falls Public Pool is open as of July 7, 2021. Please be advised that there will be no entry fee for the pool for the Summer of 2021. Please find the schedule below:

SRF Public Pool: Family Swim (20 people per session)		
Tuesday - Saturday	12:00pm – 1:00pm	3:00pm – 4:00pm
SRF Public Pool: Public Swim (20 people per session)		
Tuesday – Saturday	1:30pm – 2:30pm	4:30pm – 5:30pm

### Guidelines


All individuals will need to answer Covid-19 screening questions on the day of their visits to our facility. You also have the option to book ahead of time. Please see below for more information.

### Admission

- If you booked a swimming session, please inform the employee at the screening area at the main entrance.
- At the screening area, the employee will ask you screening questions.
- If you answered YES to any of the questions, you will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- If you answered NO to all of the questions the employee will take your temperature. If your temperature is at or above 37.8 C or 100 F you will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- You cannot at any time share items including water bottles, equipment and toys.  
\*NOTE: Children need supervision by a parent and/or guardian over the age of 14 at all times during the swim to make sure they respect and understand the rules. ### More information

- The Staff of the Public Pool will sanitize high-touch areas between each swims and at the end of the day.
- There will be NO access to change rooms. Please arrive at the pool in your bathing suit and towel. Do not bring personal effects. We are not responsible for lost or stolen objects.
- The staff must ask the patron for their highest level of swimming lessons. If they are level 6 or under, they must be in quadrant A or B. If they are level 6 or over, they can be in quadrant C or D.



### How to book a swimming session

Bookings are made through the Town Hall. You can call 705-338-2717 ext. 3 or email [townhall@townsrf.ca](mailto:townhall@townsrf.ca). You may only book one day in advance. Bookings will end at 3:30p.m. every day for the following day.

When booking in advance by phone or email, you would need to provide the following information: your name, how many people will be attending the swim, what is the highest level of swimming lessons and what is the preferable time for the swim. Only 2 quadrants per swim can be booked ahead of time.
